


WHEREAS, Section 31.05(b) Vernon's Annotated Texas Property Code, as amended, allows discounts on ad valorem taxes if paid in advance; and

3. One (1%) if the tax is paid in December.




- (1) three (3%) percent if the tax is paid in October or earlier;

WHEREAS, the budget, appended here as Exhibit A, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026, was duly presented to the City Council by Michelle Jones, City Manager, and a public hearing was ordered by the City Council and a public notice of said hearing was caused to be given by the City Council and said notice was published in *The Steel Country Bee*, and said public hearing was held according to said notice; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAINGERFIELD:

SECTION 1. That the appropriations for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026, for the support of the general government of the City of Daingerfield, Texas, be fixed and determined for said terms in accordance with the expenditures shown in the City's Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget, a copy of which is appended hereto as Exhibit A;

SECTION 2. That the Budget, as shown in words and figures in Exhibit A, is hereby approved in all respects and adopted as the City's Budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026.

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-2026**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DAINGERFIELD, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE PROPERTY TAX INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 – 2026 CITY OF DAINGERFIELD, TEXAS BUDGET AS REQUIRED BY TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE 102.007; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAINGERFIELD, TEXAS:

I. Ratification of Property Tax Increase

The City of Daingerfield, Texas acting through its duly elected Council, hereby ratifies the property tax increase of 26.96 % reflected in its fiscal year 2025-2026 budget adopted by the Council at a prior vote. This ratification was adopted in a separate vote from a vote to adopt the fiscal year 2025-2026 budget and separate from a vote to set the current tax rate required by the Texas Tax Code. This vote was taken in compliance with Texas Local Government Code 102.007

II. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances

That all ordinances, orders, resolutions heretofore passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Daingerfield, Texas, are hereby repealed to the extent that said ordinances, orders, or resolutions, or parts thereof, are in conflict herewith.

III. Severability

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any valid provision of this or any other ordinance of the City of Daingerfield, Texas.

IV. Effective Date of Ordinance

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after passage, approval and adoption.

WHEREAS, the President of the Board of Trustees of Northeast Texas Community College District has ensured the preparation of and adopted an operating budget for the College fiscal year beginning September 1, 2025, and ending August 31, 2026, the tax year 2025; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. An ad valorem tax, at the rate of two and .981 (\$.02981) cents on the hundred (\$100.00) dollar value thereof estimated in lawful currency of the United States of America, be levied to pay interest on and provide a sinking fund for Northeast Texas Community College District.**
- 2. An ad valorem tax, at the rate of eight and .019 (\$.08019) cents on the one hundred (\$100.00) dollar value thereof estimated in lawful currency of the United States of America, to be levied to pay for the support and maintenance of Northeast Texas Community College for the fiscal year beginning September 1, 2025 and ending August 31, 2026.**


