

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.512551 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Hughes Springs.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.512551 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.475190 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.512551 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Hughes Springs from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that City of Hughes Springs may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that City of Hughes Springs is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 15, 2026 AT 5:30 p.m AT Hughes Springs City Hall, 603 E. First St, Hughes Springs, TX 75656.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, City of Hughes Springs is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Tax Assessor-Collector of City of Hughes Springs at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED
AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Hughes Springs last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Hughes

Springs this year.

Total tax rate (per \$100 of value)	\$0.462000	\$0.512551	increase of 0.050551 per \$100, or 10.94%
Average homestead taxable value	\$130,358	\$136,958	increase of 5.06%
Tax on average homestead	\$602.25	\$701.98	increase of \$99.73, or 16.56%
Total tax levy on all properties	\$518,712	\$549,378	increase of \$30,666, or 5.91%
